A note on Quaker dating

Quakers referred to the months of the year by number, for example first month was March, second month April and so on to twelfth month February.

At the time when the Friends' School was founded, and like the rest of the country, they recognised the official year as beginning on the 25th day of what was called March. Thus, what today would be 20 February 1720 was to them 20th of the twelfth month 1719. In the records dual dating by old and new style years, as 1719/20, was normally used only for dates between 1 and 24 of the first month [March] where confusion was particularly liable. This system had the advantage that the numbers of the months seven to ten corresponded to the numbers in the Roman names, September and December.

The Quakers observed the reform of the calendar of 1752; but for them this meant a change in the names of the months, as well as in the beginning of the years. 10th month 1751 [December] was followed by first month 1752 [January]. Henceforth months were numbered as in the modern practice for abbreviation 20 3 1752 being 20 third month 1752, or 20 March 1752 to non-Quakers.

In the present catalogue the years pre-1752 dates are shown in dual form where the original uses old style. Months have been shown in the following form 4[6]th (meaning June) with the version used in the record first, and the later equivalent in brackets.
